THE SAFE-RIDE PROGRAM

This month's spotlight focuses on Waushara County's Safe Ride Program. To use the program, people who feel impaired can contact the bartender and request a ride. The bartender will check their driver list and calendar then make a phone call to a safe-ride driver for pick-up. Whenever possible a male driver will pick up a male patron, and a female will pick up a female. The bartender will then fill out a voucher that will go to the Tavern League treasurer. This voucher does not offer any personal information regarding the patron, and no information is shared with the Sheriff's department. The Safe Ride Program is only available at bars that are Tavern League members.

The statement below is a direct quote from Sheriff David Peterson, the sheriff of Waushara County:

"The first priority at the Sheriff's Department is to ensure everyone arrives home safely. The next priority is to arrest those persons that jeopardize the safety of themselves and others by driving under the influence. The Waushara County Tavern League should be commended for providing the safe-ride option to their patrons and the Sheriff's Department is proud to endorse their efforts. The Sheriff's Department cooperates with the Waushara County Tavern League to ensure that the safe-ride drivers as well as their passengers arrive home safely. The Sheriff's Department appreciates and commends those persons that utilize the safe-ride program."

The Sheriff's Department, tavern owners, and residences of Waushara and the surrounding counties feel that the Safe Ride Program saves lives, and prevents property damage and personal injury.

The cost for a customer using the Safe Ride Program is \$0. The costs and risks of not using this safe option are just much too high!
