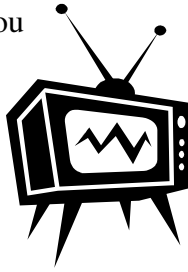
Donation Report From State on Donations overall: Pete

News in the legislation:

1. April 22, 2010 The legislature adjourned for the rest of the year. All bills that are not on the governors desk are dead and will have to be re-introduced next year.
2. April 6, 2010 Defeated – Additional tests for taverns and restaurants who sell food. Passage of this bill would have added additional costs for small business as well as being duplicative.
3. May 7, 2010 Safe-Ride bill – Increase the permissible grant amount the DOT can award to qualified Safe-Ride applicants from 60% to 80% of the cost of the program.
